

Cougar Chapter of the National Elementary Honor Society

EXPECTATIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- First year dues for this chapter shall be \$20.00. Dues will be payable to Greenfield Intermediate School (GIS) and recorded by the chapter treasurer within 30 days of induction. Annual dues, each year thereafter, shall be \$20.00. Any other official NEHS items can be purchased at the member's expense through nehs.org.
- Students must maintain a 3.90 GPA.
- Students are expected to attend all NEHS meetings – no more than one unexcused absence for the school year. Membership meetings will be scheduled once a month, after school from 2:10 - 3:15 pm.
- Serious discipline offenses are subject to review for possible dismissal.
 - Principal, Assistant Principal, and NEHS leadership will meet to determine possible dismissal.
- Students must participate in the two chapter service projects during the school year.
- Students must complete an individual service project(s) of a minimum of four (4) service hours that reflect his or her particular talent and interest. Service hours will be validated by submitting a chapter form to the faculty council.
 1. No profit can be made by the individual for the service he/she renders unless that profit is given over to the Cougar Chapter of the National Elementary Honor Society under such circumstances as fund-raising activities.
 2. All charity work will count for service hours, including service to church and community.
 3. No family activity will be accepted as credit to required service hours.
 4. No activity related directly to the service of other clubs will be accepted as credit towards required service hours (Example: student council, K-Kids, Boy/Girl Scouts).
 5. The four hours of service credit must include a minimum of two hours in each of the two categories, school and community, per year.
 6. Appropriate service hours will be accepted only if service was rendered during the actual academic year.
 7. If a member has accumulated fewer than four service hours by the second week in May, he/she will be removed from membership in the Elementary National Honor Society. Note: A semester of probation will NOT be granted for failing to meet the service requirement by May 15th of the current school year.
