- (NEW) NWEA Middle of the Year Assessment Results Please make sure you look at your child's winter NWEA scores. These are very important in understanding your child's academic progress. You can find your child's NWEA scores in the Powerschool Parent Portal. If you have questions regarding your child's scores, please contact your child's teachers.
- (NEW) 5th and 6th Grade Growth and Development Lessons Parents of 5th and 6th grade students, you will find an attachment included on this email describing our annual growth and development programming that is upcoming next month. Please read through the attachment for details regarding this. If you would prefer your student opt out of this program, you must submit this in writing to our main office.
- (NEW) CogAT Assessment 6th grade students will be taking our annual CogAT assessment starting next week and will continue through the following week. The CogAT assessment appraises the cognitive development of students from kindergarten through grade 12. The test measures students' learned reasoning abilities that are learned in and out of school. The questions in the assessment require students to demonstrate their reasoning abilities in the areas of verbal reasoning, quantitative reasoning, and nonverbal reasoning. Additionally, this assessment is used as one of the pathways for high ability identification in GC schools.
