



Kids Talk through Aspire Indiana presents Body Boundaries (a K-6th Grade evidence-based program) to the Greenfield-Central Community School Corporation

Kids Talk has developed an evidence-based program for students in grades K-12 that instructs children on what to do if faced with abuse. These programs are customized according to the cognitive abilities of children of all ages and are based on criteria determined by the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children and by Gunderson National Child Protection Training Center.

The program will be presented to students at Greenfield Intermediate School on February 1st and 2nd. Presentations will occur in 4th grade classrooms on Thursday, February 1 and in 5th and 6th grade classrooms on Friday, February 2. Although not mandatory, each child's attendance in the program is strongly recommended.
