## A Few Important Items:

- (NEW) NWEA End-of-Year Assessment - Please make sure you look at your child's spring NWEA scores. These are very important in understanding your child's academic progress throughout this school year. You can find NWEA scores in the Powerschool Parent Portal. If you have questions regarding your child's scores, please contact your child's teachers.

- **(NEW)** Clinic News - Any medications stored in the clinic must be picked up by the end of the last school day. State law prohibits us from sending it home with students. Any medication left in the clinic after this time will be disposed of properly.

- **(NEW REMINDER) GCJHS Band** - Attention all 6<sup>th</sup> grade students and parents! As you are preparing to transition to the Junior High next year, have you considered becoming a part of the "Cougar Pride" Band program? Plans will need to be made by the end of this current school year, as student schedules for 7<sup>th</sup> grade will be based around their participation in Band (and/or Choir or Violin), and which instrument a student chooses to play.
